The performances and instruction of our young singers represent a joint effort of the Peninsula Education Foundation and the Palos Verdes Peninsula Unified School District. Your school's performance date is:

Tuesday, March 26, 2019, 7:30 p.m. – Dapplegray, Vista Grande, Mira Catalina, and Pt. Vicente Elementary Schools

As you sit in the audience and look at the stage: Dapplegray is on the left side of the stage (green room side), Vista Grande and Mira Catalina are in the center, and Pt. Vicente is on the right side of the stage (piano side).

IMPORTANT DETAILS:

Rehearsal: Date: Same day as performance (see above for your school)
Place: **Norris Theatre** (27570 Crossfield Dr., Rolling Hills Estates) – enter through the side entrance door called "green room"
Time: **3:05 p.m.-3:15 p.m.** – singers should be on stage (in school clothes) at this time
Pick-up time: **Between 4:50 p.m.-5:00 p.m.** (No supervision after 5:00 p.m.)
Please do NOT bring backpacks or other valuables to the rehearsal or concert.

Concert: Arrival Time: Between **7:00 p.m.** and 7:10 p.m. (No supervision before 7:00 p.m.)
Entry: Singers only, enter through side entrance "green room"
Parents should enter through the main theatre entrance
Performance: Concert begins at **7:30 p.m.** and will last about an hour
Pick-up Location: Meet your child outside the green room immediately following the concert

Dress: Boys: Long-sleeved, white dress shirt; dark dress slacks; dark shoes.
Girls: Plain, white blouse (without any other colors); dark, solid-colored skirt with black tights or nice dark pants; dark shoes. No jeans, please.

Tickets: The Norris Theatre has a seating capacity of approximately 440. Tickets priced at \$22.00 will be available at the theater box office (telephone 544-0403) on February 6, 2018. You do not need to purchase tickets for members of the chorus, but you do need tickets for all other members of your family (**no matter what their ages**) and friends who will attend. (Note: A facility fee of \$7.00 per ticket will be charged by the theater)

Tickets are also available online, but you should **go to the box office or call the Norris Theater** if you have any questions before purchasing. Remember, if your school is standing on "stage right" or the "green room" side, you should purchase tickets diagonally across from them and if your school is standing on "stage left" or the "piano" side, you should purchase tickets diagonally across from them. If your school is standing in the center, all seats should be good.

CAMERAS OF ANY KIND ARE NOT PERMITTED. The performances will be videotaped and later shown on Cox Cable Channel 3 several times. You may make your own copies from the airing of the program on Channel 3.

Please note: **It is important that every singer be at the rehearsal.** We request your child's presence at the rehearsal, even though some may have conflicting activities during this rehearsal time. Please reschedule or cancel conflicting appointments ahead of time. The concert is a one-time event with only one rehearsal for the combined choruses. This concert is the culmination of several months of hard work, so please make this one-time rehearsal and concert your utmost priority.

Please mark your calendar for this special event! Bring your family. Invite your friends. **The proceeds from this evening fund the elementary choral music program.** We look forward to seeing you at the concert!
